



Join the Historic Warwick Walk

Saturday 30th March

Marking the start of English Tourism Week, the walk is an easy stroll round some of the county town's most famous buildings, while professional guide Paula Fletcher tells some of the rich history of Warwick – the Dwelling by the Weir.

Starting at the Jury Street Court House, Warwick's Town Hall, the historic walk takes in the Collegiate Church of St. Mary with the tombs of the Earls of Warwick in the famous Beauchamp Chapel. We visit the Market Place with its pubs and dining places and the County Museum, once the cloth-market; the 14th century Lord Leycester Hospital; the imposing former Crown Court and execution site; and the most elegant Georgian Terrace in the county, built after the Great Fire of Warwick.
